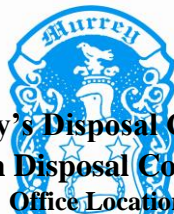

At Murrey's and American Disposal, we are committed to providing our customers with options that will help **YOU** make the right choice to reduce your monthly bill.

4 Easy Ways to reduce your overall disposal bill:

- 1) **Participate** in the Recycling Program to receive a discounted garbage rate.
- 2) Learn **what** to recycle and encourage others to participate.
- 3) **Reduce and Reuse** to minimize what you are throwing away.
- 4) Evaluate your garbage **can size or collection frequency** for the most cost effective service.

Recycling in Pierce County is governed by the County's Minimum service level ordinance and is a mandatory pay/voluntary subscription service. If you choose to participate in the recycling program, you will receive a **discounted** garbage rate. We provide curbside recycling and will pick up on a biweekly basis - - the same days as your solid waste collection. Recycling is easy and saves resources, and we provide a 96-gallon wheeled recycling cart. Items accepted are conveniently listed on the lid for verification. Since glass products are **excluded** from the comingled recycling program, we have placed glass drop-off sites throughout the County for your convenience.

On a subscription basis we offer **Yard Waste** recycling. Customers receive a 90-gallon wheeled container for their use, to be placed at the curb on collection day. Please do not put plastic bags or other unacceptable material in the yard waste container.

Acceptable Yard Waste: Leaves, grass, weeds, shrubs, and other compostable organic materials from pruning. Brush, branches and roots cannot be larger than 4 inches in diameter and must fit into the container with the lid closed.

Unacceptable Yard Waste: Stumps, demolition wood, large amounts of dirt, rocks, glass, plastics, flowerpots, metal, concrete, asphalt, bones, ashes, manure and animal waste, or other non-organic debris such as pizza boxes. **Extra yard waste should be placed next to your container in untied compostable bags.** A small additional fee will be charged for each extra bag. Yard waste placed in plastic bags or non-compostable bags will not be accepted. ****Please remember food waste is not an acceptable yard waste item.****

Garbage Can Size: Selecting the correct size is important. A standard can is 32-gallons and a mini can is 20-gallons. We offer weekly or once-a-month service – be sure your can(s) and recycling containers are at curbside by 7:00 a.m.! The weight limit for the standard 32-gallon can is 45 lbs. Keep in mind, overfilled or overweight cans, additional bags, boxes, or cans larger than 32-gallons will cost extra. Be sure to select the number of cans that meets your needs and give **recycling** a chance to work for **YOU!**



On March 1, 2016, the tipping fee in Pierce County increased by 0.6 % or from \$144.97 per ton to \$145.84 per ton. This change is reflected in your rate and was calculated according to the requirements of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission. Instead of sales tax on garbage service, the State of Washington charges a 3.6% Refuse Collection Tax.

Payment Options: You may pay by mail with check, money order, or a credit card payment can be made by phone or through our website. We accept Visa, MasterCard, and American Express. For our online bill pay option, please visit www.murreysdisposal.com. Payments can also be made at our office (4822 70th Ave E, Fife, WA 98424). Office hours are 7:30am-5pm (Mon.-Fri.).

Inclement Weather: If we are unable to provide service due to weather and/or road conditions your driver will take extra bags/cans on your next regularly scheduled pick up equivalent to your missed service at no additional charge. **No credit will be issued** for missed pick up due to inclement weather. Please call our office to confirm if your service was delayed due to weather.
